At the end of every level (1-4), students meet with the academic office for review and promotion.

Format of the Courses

The Master of Divinity Online Degree program combines three distinct course formats, offering students a well-rounded and flexible learning experience. Students will participate in each of these formats throughout their studies:

1. Fully Pre-Recorded Courses

These courses are entirely accessible on the Canvas Learning Management System. With all lectures and assignments pre-recorded, students have 24/7 access to materials for the full 8-week duration, allowing them to learn at their own pace. A facilitator will be available throughout the course for ongoing support.

2. Zoom-Based Live Virtual Courses

Some courses are conducted live on Zoom, typically in the evenings, featuring real-time lectures, interactive discussions, and Q&A sessions. This format fosters an engaging and collaborative environment with instructors and fellow students.

3. Residential Courses (Annually, One Course)

Each summer, students are invited to campus for a five-day intensive course, providing a traditional classroom setting and a hands-on seminary experience in a focused period.

Together, these formats create a comprehensive educational experience, allowing students to fulfill their program requirements through a balanced combination of flexible, interactive, and immersive learning.

Objectives of the Program

The program aims to accomplish the following in the lives of the students:

- To cultivate a profound understanding of Scripture and the rich theological heritage of the Church. Through rigorous study, students will dive into the depths of God's Word and the historical context.
- To equip students with practical skills essential for effective pastoral care, leadership, and ethical decision-making. We believe in nurturing leaders who not only understand the theory but can apply their knowledge with wisdom and compassion in real-world situations.
- To foster personal transformation and spiritual development in student. The program provides a nurturing environment for individuals to deepen their faith, cultivating a spirit of continuous growth and reflection.
- To enhance students' communication skills, empowering them to deliver impactful sermons that resonate with the hearts of their congregations.
- To prepare students for the evolving challenges and opportunities they may encounter. We aim to equip students with the adaptability and resilience needed to thrive in today's diverse ministry contexts.
- To instil a deep sense of commitment to ministry and social engagement. We believe that Christian service extends beyond the church walls, and our goal is to nurture individuals who actively engage with and impact their communities.

• To inspire a lifelong commitment in students to grow in the likeness of Christ. This commitment forms the bedrock of their ministry, guiding them in their service to God and humanity.

Duration of the Program

Our program is designed to meet the diverse needs of our students, offering a flexible journey to complete your degree in as little as 3 years or up to 8 years, depending on your personal schedule. Structured in a modular format, the program consists of 30 modules, each lasting 8 weeks.

For those eager to progress quickly, you can take two modules simultaneously, while those who prefer a steadier pace can complete one module at a time. Each course generally requires about 12–15 hours of learning each week. If your goal is to finish within 3 years, you can increase your weekly learning hours to move through the program at an accelerated rate.

Accreditation of the Program

The program received in-principle approval from the Asia Theological Association (ATA) in June 2023 for its launch. In September 2024, it underwent an initial review by ATA and received positive feedback. We now look forward to the upcoming accreditation visit from ATA. We are committed to maintaining high standards, and upon successful program completion, students will be awarded ATA-certified degree.

Financial Information

The tuition fee of the program has been kept minimal compared to the quality of education provided.

- Admission fee: ₹2000.
- Tuition fee: The total tuition fee for the entire program is ₹90,000, but scholarships are made available for all students in need, up to ₹24,000. Students with scholarship will only pay ₹66,000 for the entire tuition. This means over 36 months, student will be paying ₹1833 per month. Fee payments can be made as per the courses or monthly or in installments.
- ATA Registration fee: ₹2000.
- Graduation & Transcript Fee: ₹2000.

Admission Requirements

- Born-Again Commitment: Candidates must demonstrate a born-again commitment and a fervent dedication to effectively serve in Christian ministry. A sincere desire to deepen understanding of God's Word is essential.
- 2. Educational Qualification: Candidates should be at least 25 years old and hold a bachelor's degree from a recognized institution, either in secular or theological education. Individuals with a minimum of 5 years of ministry experience and aged over 30 may be considered, even if they do not possess a bachelor's degree, on a case-by-case basis. Please contact us for confirmation.
- 3. **Technological Requirements:** Candidates are required to have access to a personal computer with stable internet connectivity to facilitate seamless online learning.
- 4. **Spiritual Mentorship:** Candidates should have a local pastor or a trusted spiritual leader who can serve as a mentor throughout their studies for ministerial skill development.
- 5. **Minimum Fluency in English:** Candidates are expected to have a basic proficiency in English to effectively express themselves. Depending on their initial assessment, candidates may need to undergo a qualifying exam or an interview to evaluate their capability to succeed in our programs.

Document Submission Required for Admission

- Educational Certificates: Scanned copies of 10th, 12th, and degree certificates along with mark sheets. Please note that only scanned copies are accepted.
- **Personal Testimony Letter:** A typed account of your personal faith journey and reasons for pursuing the selected program.
- **Recommendation Letter:** A letter from a mentor or someone familiar with your commitment to faith and passion for theological studies.
- Formal Digital Profile Image: A soft copy of a formal profile image for student profile.
- Identification Document: A scanned copy of an ID card, such as an Aadhar Card or any national identity card.
- Mentor Consent Form: Ensure your mentor submits the digital consent form to confirm their mentorship role. Click <u>here</u> to access and share the mentor form

with your mentor.

- Ministry Experience Documentation (if applicable): Applicants without a bachelor's degree must provide proof of at least five years of ministry experience, including specific details on the nature and duration of the involvement. This can be a scanned document,
- Scholarship Form: If you have opted for the 8000 rupees annual scholarship, you need to digitally submit the scholarship form during your application. Click <u>here</u> to access and submit your scholarship request form.

Academic Calendar (January 1- December 31)

Term 1: From January 1-7 to February 19-25 (8 Weeks)

Term 2: From February 26-March 4 to April 16-22 (8 Weeks)

Term 3: From April 23-29 to July 2-8 (8 Week Term + 1 Week Residency, 2 week Vacation)

Term 4: From July 9-15 to August 27 - September 2 (8 Weeks)

Term 5: From September 3-9 to October 15-21 (7 Weeks)

Term 6: From October 22-28 to December 10-31 (8 Week Term + 2 Week Vacation)

Each term begins with a new set of courses, typically spanning 8 weeks. Students will enroll in courses and complete them within the designated time frame. Extensions are available for a nominal fee, providing additional time when needed.

Wholistic Formation Framework

The M.Div program equips students for effective Christian ministry through a holistic approach that integrates spiritual growth, character formation, and practical ministry experience. Below framework is designed to nurture students in every aspect of their spiritual and ministerial journey.

Spiritual Mentorship Program

Students engage in one-on-one mentorship with experienced ministry leaders for personal guidance and spiritual growth. Monthly meetings foster accountability and development, with mentors submitting progress reports to ensure continuous support. Personal mentor has to be chosen by the student himself/herself.

Virtual Chapels

Online students gather for interactive worship, prayer, and fellowship through virtual chapels. These sessions cultivate a sense of community and encourage spiritual engagement.

Ministry Internships

Practical ministry experience is an integral part of the program, with students completing a 360-hour internship after completing at least 50% of their coursework. Internships allow students to apply their theological training in real-world contexts, guided by mentors and a formation coordinator. Student can choose the place and context of the internship.

Annual Campus Visits

Students are required to visit the campus annually for a 5-day immersive experience, strengthening connections with the community through workshops, prayer services, and events.
